Who needs a Child Student Visa



You will need to apply for a Child Student Visa if:

- Age between 4 17
- Have an unconditional offer (met the schools entry requirements)
- UK Independent, fee-paying school with an accredited Sponsor Licence
- Intend to study a course of at least 6 months



Who do not need a Child Studen Visa



You do not need to apply for a Child Student Visa if:

- Age 18+ (Student Visa)
- Course is less than 6 months (One or Two Terms) Visitor status
 - Signed Parental Consent Letter by both biological parents
 - Evidence of sole custody
 - Copy of return flight details
 - E-gates
 - Invitation letter from school
 - BUT, if the term is longer than 180 in total = Visa



What is the application proces





Apply

You must apply online for a Child Student visa.

Check which documents you'll need to apply.

Apply outside the UK

As part of your application, you'll need to prove your identity. How you do this depends on where you're from and what type of passport you have.


You'll either:

- have your fingerprints and photograph taken at a visa application centre
- use the 'UK Immigration: ID Check' app to scan your identity document (you'll also create or sign into your UK Visas and Immigration account)

You'll be told what you need to do when you apply.

Once you've started your application, you can save your form and complete it later.



You will need a passport with a biometric chip.

Scan your passport and upload a photo of yourself


To confirm your identity, you will use the free UK Immigration: ID Check app to scan your passport with a biometric chip and upload a photo of yourself.

If you are applying for someone else, the applicant needs to confirm their identity - you can help them use the app.

If you cannot use the app to confirm your identity

You will need to go to a visa application centre after you apply instead. Visa application centres are not available in all countries.





Check you can use the app

You can use the app on:

- an iPhone 7 or newer models
- an Android phone with near-field communication (NFC)

Check the phone's settings to see if it has NFC. The phone has NFC if you can use it to make contactless payments.

If you do not have a phone

Ask a friend or family member if you can use their phone. No information is stored on the app or phone after you close it.

You do not have to apply on the phone - you can do the rest of your application on your computer or another device.

We will send your decision letter by email – this can be your email or someone else's. You do not use your decision letter to prove your status.





Create a UK Visas and Immigration account

To use this service, you need to create an account.

Once you have an account, you can use it to confirm your identity, apply and use other Home Office services.

What you need

You will need your:

- date of birth
- passport
- email address
- phone number

If you need to give someone application access so they can apply for you, you also need their email address and phone number.

Who can create an account

You can create an account for yourself or someone else in some cases - for example, your young child.

Possible issues you may come across



- UK Immigration ID Check App
 - Multiple attempts to scan biometric chip
 - Logs out after a certain amount wait 24 hours
 - Make sure the phone touch the cover of the passport



- Payments IHS
 - Do not accept all credit cards
 - After the 5th attempt blocks application
 - Have to start again



What is next



- Decision time can take up to 3 weeks or longer between June to September

Sharing information about your permission to stay in the UK (your immigration status)

You can view and prove your immigration status online, via the 'view and prove your immigration status' service – https://www.gov.uk/view-prove-immigration-status. This online service provides a secure record and proof of your immigration status which is held digitally by the Home Office and which is available to you at all times. This service is made available to you instead of a Biometric Residence Permit.

Employers, landlords or other organisation may need to check your immigration status to see if you are allowed to work, rent property or access services. The online view and prove service can be used to share your immigration status information





- Not sending out decision email another way to check is to try to log into: <u>https://www.gov.uk/view-prove-immigration-status</u>
 - You will need your child's passport and/or date of birth
 - If you are able to log into the above link, it means the visa was approved and you will be able to generate a share code

What to do next



Give this share code and your date of birth to the person you want to prove your status to.



To see your status, they must enter the share code and your date of birth at www.gov.uk/check-immigration-status.



Contact them to make sure they have all the information they need.

To prove your status to someone else, you can re-use this code or create a new code - there is no limit to how many codes can be used at the same time.
